Angler 2 (brand name) - Saves time when sewing angles for diagonal corners, flying geese, star points, and half-square triangles.

Gammill longarm and Statler Stitcher - because quilting makes the quilt and this machine allows for computer guided precision and for hand work as an alternative.

Needle Threader

Pointy Tweezers - threading the machine and taking out paper from foundation piecing

Rotary Cutter- the ease and accuracy of use, time saver, and better than templates

Ruler - accuracy is so important!
