## What is your weirdest quilting tool and why?

A block of foam used to put pressure on the quilt so that hand guiding the long arm machine is easier to control.

Magnetic Pin Dish - hardware store, big, heavy-duty, for screws

Plastic tub from candy - for storage of small items for quilting.

Sandpaper - attached to a clipboard to prevent slipping when making lines on fabric.

Soap sliver - so old-fashioned, self-made.

SortKwik (Brand name) non-toxic, non-staining fingertip moistener to give you "grip" with the fabric.

Soup Spoon for basting a quilt.

Zip-loc bags for organizing
